The IB Diploma at Herlufsholm

The IB Diploma is a globally recognised pre university programme and has been an integral part of Herlufsholm for over 15 years.

The Diploma is made up of six core subjects and three core components as shown here.

When choosing subjects in the IB it is important to consider future plans and university application requirements.



Please take the following information into consideration

before choosing subjects - changing subjects during the school year may not be possible, and only at the discretion of the IB Coordinator.

Choose your subjects with the future in mind

Herlufsholm will make sure Prep IB students have been exposed to all IB subjects before making their subject choices for IB. It is important to consider further education before handing in final subject choices – future university courses may have specific requirements.

During the first year in IB, we will introduce students to the application procedure for Danish and British universities. We provide application guidance, share application deadlines, and ensure that students have been recommended a suitable level in mathematics.

Students have to look into specific course requirements and deadlines for application. Be aware that some may differ from the university's normal deadline. When wishing to make a university application, it is crucial that the student takes initiative, is actively involved in every step of the application process, and meets all deadlines. Please contact the student counsellor when it is time to start the application process.

Things to keep in mind when applying to universities in...

Denmark

Mathematics

A significant proportion of courses require Mathematics at a level equivalent to the Danish B level (Math SL on IB).

Danish speaking Math studies students have the opportunity to follow an upgrade course in the spring of 3.i and take the Math B exam in June of 3.i.

Danish

Certain courses require a Danish level equivalent to STX A and in these cases, Dan B SL is not sufficient.

• IB to Danish Conversion scale

IB points are converted to an equivalent Danish grade on application to Danish universities following a strict conversion scale.

Subject Combinations

As there are minimum subject requirements for the vast majority of Danish courses, students are advised to check the requirements of individual courses.
