RULES FOR ROUND SQUARE EXCHANGES

Below are a few things that you need to consider carefully and understand.

While on exchange you are acting as an ambassador of Denmark and more specifically Herlufsholm Skole. This is a position not to be taken lightly, as your time with the host school obviously leaves a deep and lasting impression and one that will affect future exchange prospects with that institution. To help you with this, read and understand the following points and why they are in place

- A. The student must abide by the regulations of the particular school concerned.
 - B. You must act positively as a member of the school and boarding house or host family and fulfill responsibilities and perform duties appropriate to your age.
 - C. While visiting the host country, you must abide by its laws.
 - D. You may be permitted to travel only when you are accompanied by a staff member, host parents or when participating in an organised trip. At any other time it is with the express permission of the Host Houseparent/Headteacher of the Host School.
 - E. You will keep a journal while on exchange and be prepared to give a written report of your exchange for publication in your host school's magazine/journal. You will make a presentation to a school assembly.
- * Engaging in any of the following acts during the period of the exchange jeopardizes the continuation of the exchange and may cause the host school to return you to your school.

These acts include the following:

- 1) driving a motorcycle or motor vehicle without express permission
- 2) absenteeism from school without proper reasons
- 3) possession or use of a narcotic drug
- 4) disobeying school rules regarding alcoholic beverages and smoking
- 5) disobeying other published rules and regulations of the host school

Udvekslingskontrakt

Det at komme på udveksling er på alle måder en uforglemmelig oplevelse, som vil være med til at udvikle dig og vise dig mere om, hvad du indeholder som menneske foruden at give dig et indblik i en anden kultur og skolesystem. For at det hele skal forløbe så smidigt som muligt for alle parter, er der en række forhold, du og dine forældre skal være opmærksomme på, inden du søger.

Når du har fået tilkendegivelse om at vi vil forsøge at etablere en udveksling til dig, kan det være en god ide at kigge forbi Marianne Ring i fritidskontoret eller Ann Hansen på Round Square kontoret løbende (et par gange om ugen) for at holde dig orienteret om udviklingen.

Når kontakten er etableret via velkomstbrevet, gælder det om at skabe en god korrespondance de to familier imellem. Det er en del af udviklingsprocessen og bidrager til en vellykket udveksling. Så find hinanden på mail, Facebook eller andre medier hurtigst muligt.

Det kan være en god ide at udskrive alt information og samle i en mappe samt notere spørgsmål ned, som de opstår. Det kan dreje sig om alt fra lommepenge, sengetider, tøjvask mm. Round Square kontoret har desuden en liste med spørgsmål til inspiration, som kan rekvireres. Sørg for at tage en skype-samtale eller skriv med udvekslingspartneren før udvekslingen for at få afklaret de spørgsmål, der evt. måtte være.

At indgå i en udveksling er en forpligtelse i forhold til en anden skole og familie. Hvis man i forløbet imod forventning skifter mening og ikke vil udveksles alligevel, får det en række konsekvenser for de andre involverede parter. Det er ikke sjovt pludselig at stå uden en værtsfamilie så derfor forventer vi at når du har søgt en udveksling og vi har fundet en udvekslingspartner til dig, at du vedstår dit tilbud om at være vært for en anden elev. Så tænk på udvekslingen som en fantastisk mulighed, men også som en forpligtelse og et ansvar.

Når du er ude:

Rejseomkostninger, et eventuelt depositum, lommepenge samt forsikringer, betaler du selv. Derudover er opholdet omkostningsfrit. Enkelte skoler tilbyder deltagelse i camps eller andre ture, det vil komme ud over, såfremt du vælger at takke ja hertil. Hvis omkostninger er et vigtigt parameter, så tal med Ann Hansen om det, når du søger, da de endelige omkostninger kan variere meget. De endelige datoer skal godkendes af Ann Hansen og den udvekslingsansvarlige på den anden skole. Når det er sket, har I ansvaret for at købe billetter, sørge for visum, forsikring, eventuelle vaccinationer og udfyldelse af papirer fra udvekslingsskolen. Vi står for det rent formelle arbejde med at etablere den indledende kontakt og sikre kommunikationen og vil gerne være behjælpelige ved eventuelle tvivlsspørgsmål. Overordnet forventes det dog, at I selv tager jer af alt det praktiske.

Du skal følge undervisningen på udvekslingsskolen, og derfor føres du ikke fraværende under opholdet. Det fritager dig dog ikke for ansvar for at sætte dig ind i pensum, inden faget afsluttes. Det forventes desuden, at du vælger to fag, som du følger med i under udlandsopholdet. Det indebærer at du har bøgerne til faget med og at du overholder afleveringsdatoer for opgaver mm. De andre fag kan du indhente efter behov efter hjemkomst. Vores statistik over karakterudvikling efter et udvekslingsforhold giver ingen anledninger til bekymring på den front.

Du skal være tilmeldt Herlufsholm skole i hele udvekslingsperioden. Skolepenge betales derfor stadig til Herlufsholm og ikke til udvekslingsskolen. Nogle udvekslingsskoler kræver dog et depositum, som kan dække særlige aktiviteter, man deltager i under opholdet.

Medbring gerne en lille gave til værtsfamilien og til udvekslingskoordinatoren på den modtagende skole.

Vær åben og imødekommende over for de mennesker og den kultur, du møder. Grib alle muligheder.

Deltag aktivt og engageret i alle aktiviteter – det er et godt råd at tilmelde dig mange fritidsaktiviteter på skolen.

Husk at du repræsenterer Herlufsholm. Klæd dig derfor under hensynstagen til den lokale dresscode og vær generelt velsoigneret og velklædt. Læs gerne vores hæfte til studieture, de samme retningslinier gælder for din udveksling.

Vi anbefaler, at kontakten til familie og venner i Danmark begrænses for at minimere hjemve. Fordyb dig i stedet i det lokale liv; på den måde får du så meget som muligt ud af opholdet.

Når du kommer hjem

Når du er vært

Du og din familie skal være indstillet på at være værter for den udvekslingselev, der kommer til Herlufsholm.

Det indbefatter afhentning og aflevering i lufthavnen, for kostelever gælder det at have eleven boende i rejseweekender og evt. ferier, støtte til at komme til og fra skolen, og det er værd at bemærke at dagelever vil som udgangspunkt have eleven boende hjemme hos sig under hele udvekslingen.

Det kan være en spændende kulturel oplevelse at deltage i familiearrangementer og fester som fx konfirmationer og fødselsdage, og det forventes at man inkluderer eleven i den slags oplevelser. Samtidig er der også en stor glæde ved at vise vores danske kultur og traditioner til et ungt menneske med en anden baggrund. Vis gerne eleven lidt af Danmark. Mange af vores udvekslingselever kommer langvejsfra, og får sandsynligvis ikke mulighed for at se Danmark igen.

Tænk på, hvordan I gerne vil have at jeres søn/datter bliver modtaget af sin værtsfamilie; det er et godt pejlemærke, for hvordan I giver udvekslingselev et godt ophold.
