

# IB Chemistry teacher required, Herlufsholm School



Herlufsholm School is looking to recruit an IB DP Chemistry **Teacher from 1**<sup>st</sup> **January 2025**, or as soon as possible thereafter. The position can be either full-time or part-time. Experience of teaching the IB program or in English would be beneficial, but not essential. The role could also include general science teaching in the Pre-IB.

We are a small IB department in a larger Danish gymnasium. The IB teaching team works very closely in order to ensure the best conditions for teaching and learning for our international students. In general, our science classes in IB are small (4-10 students) allowing teachers to form close learning relationships with students and provide greater opportunities for nurturing individual progress.

The ideal candidate would have a passion for the teaching of chemistry and the wider sciences, have a fluency in English that would enable student learning, and have a structured and targeted approach to developing subject curriculums.

The school has in recent years implemented a raft of new pedagogical approaches of which the new candidate would be expected to be part of and help develop.
